A significant change at our school this year has been the addition of the new multipurpose facility. This construction has been a blessing to watch and see how God's people can unite in a worthy cause. Many have contributed, but much more is needed. Due to the construction there are some adjustments we need to make you aware of concerning the upcoming school year. The entrance procedures into the school are as follows. Cars and buses will approach as usual, but please be aware of construction equipment and barricades as you enter the yard. For the first 2 days grades pre - k through 4th will meet and enter on the Lawndale St. side of the building. Grades 5th - 8th will meet and enter on the Bingham St. side of the building. Starting Monday Sept. 12 all students will gather on the Bingham St. side. The main entrance to the building will still be on the Lawndale side, but construction vehicles will also be coming and going so please be very cautious and follow the barricaded pathways.

Another very important adjustment is in our lunch program. For at least the first full week of school all students will have to bring a sack lunch. Drinks and snacks will be available for purchase. We have looked at various temporary lunch options and we will be sending home literature with your child during the first week of school detailing procedures for the first few months. Once our new facility is fully functional new information about lunches will be conveyed.
