Dear Parent/Guardian:

On Friday, October 7, 2011, CGCA will be having its annual school picnic at Burholme Park. There will be a noon dismissal on this day. Every school family is invited and encouraged to come to the picnic which takes place after the morning Race For Education. **It is important, however, for each student to have an adult taking responsibility for him/her.** The adult can be the parent or a designated guardian.

This will be a fun afternoon with games to play. Cedar Grove will provide each student and his/her parent/guardian(s) with a bag of chips, soda, and a Tastykake. Extra sodas may be purchased at the picnic for \$.50. *(The homeroom teacher will be giving out the tickets at the park {to the oldest child in the family} in order to receive these items.)* The student and his/her parent/guardian should plan on bringing their own sandwich, hoagie, or whatever else they would like to eat.

It is necessary to fill out only ***one form per family*** whether your child will be attending or not. These forms need to be turned into the oldest child's homeroom teacher as soon as possible. *(These forms will be used to determine how many drinks, snacks, and Tastykakes CGCA will need to have in order to accommodate everyone in attendance.)*

Students attending the picnic may be picked up at school at 12:00 p.m., or they may go to Burholme Park (Cottman Ave. and Central Ave.) on the CGCA bus or van. Either way, parents/guardians must be prepared to take responsibility for each student at the park no later than 12:30 p.m.
