FEES SCHEDULE FOR PRESCHOOL STUDENTS

2018–2019

Nursery – 3 years old by June 1; PreKindergarten – 4 years old by September 1
Kindergarten – 5 years old by September 1

Morning Program – meets for 3 3/4 hours from 8:15 a.m. to 12:00 noon

School Day Program – meets from 8:15 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Full Day Program – hours available from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

(Extra time outside of the Program selected will be billed at the current daycare hourly rate of \$5.25)

Nursery Program

- Morning Program – **8:15-12:00** \$290 per month
- School Day Program – **8:15 – 3:00** \$455 per month
- Full Day Program – **7:00 – 6:00** \$580 per month

PreKindergarten Program

- Morning Program – **8:15 – 12:00** \$305 per month
- School Day Program – **8:15 – 3:00** \$480 per month
- Full Day Program – **7:00 – 6:00** \$600 per month

Kindergarten Program

- Morning Program – **8:15 – 12:00** \$315 per month
- School Day Program – **8:15 – 3:00** \$500 per month
- Full Day Program – **7:00 – 6:00** \$615 per month

Other Fees (*non refundable*):

Application fee: \$25 per child

Testing Fee for Pre-K and Kindergarten only: \$50/child (Feb. -- Aug.)

{cash or money order only} \$75/child (Sept. – Jan.)

Registration Fee: \$200/child

Preschool tuition is broken down into 10 monthly payments beginning in August and ending in May. It is paid by automatic withdrawals from your checking or statement savings account using F.A.C.T.S. Management Company to process the withdrawals. (The automatic withdrawals are **not optional** unless a family chooses to prepay the entire tuition by August 1.) There is a one-time yearly processing fee of \$45 charged by F.A.C.T.S.

Please note: There is a 10% early withdrawal fee (of the yearly tuition or 1 monthly payment) if a child is withdrawn before the end of the academic year at the request of the Academy or the parent.

*Due to our religious affiliation, CGCA is exempt from PA State Licensure for our PreKindergarten and Nursery programs. However, CGCA makes every effort as a school to maintain or exceed these standards and be in compliance.
