We hope you had a wonderful summer and are excited about the new school year. We are currently making preparations for our fall athletics. Our Middle School Interscholastic Outdoor Soccer Teams have started. The teams will consist of middle school boys and girls grades 5-8. There will be approximately 13 games for boys soccer and 8 for girls soccer. Home outdoor games will be played at Burholme Park. Away games will be played at various locations, but will originate and end at the Academy. If you are interested in having your child participate, please fill out the form below and return it right away. Games and practices will primarily be Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays right after school till 5:00 no more than 3 times per week. On game days we are usually back to school by 5:00-5:30. Return times will be posted on schedules on our website ([www.CGCA.org](http://www.CGCA.org)). Updates and posts will be on our website and sent out via email. Be sure to check regularly. **There is a \$20 activity fee due the first day of practice.** Any injuries sustained due to participation in CGCA athletics must first be submitted to the family's insurance provider and expenses covered by that insurance. CGCA's insurance is secondary. Tryouts/practices are Tuesday and Wednesday next week. Practices these first 2 half day are 12:00 – 1:30. Players can be picked up at Burholme by 1:30 or at school by 2:00. Practices on Thursday and Friday are 3-5. Games begin the following week.

**Concussion Policy:** Concussions are both a medical and educational issue. After sustaining a concussion, and before the student returns to school, the school nurse should receive a letter from the physician. The letter should describe the student's injury and the specific and necessary modifications to the student's school day. Additional physician recommendation/documentation must be provided as the student recovers, to continue, make changes to, or discontinue the academic plans that have been put in place. The school will make every effort to follow the accommodations as directed by the physician to help the student to recover and gradually return to a full course load. The school will make adjustments to the student's attendance as suggested by the physician recommendations. The initial focus should be return to school before return to sports, so students must be cleared by the physician and written orders provided to the school nurse before the student can return to gym, sports, or activities.
