**SUMMER READING PROGRAM:** Readers are leaders. To help keep students in the good habit of reading over the summer, a minimum of 3 age-appropriate books are required to be read by CGCA students entering grades 1-5. Students who read 10 or more books will receive a certificate in the fall. Record the title, author, number of pages, and parent signature for each book read on 3” x 5” or 5” x 8” cards. These reports are due when returning to school on August 26, 2026. Students entering grades 6-11 must follow the guidelines on the CGCA Summer Reading list.
